COVID-19 Long-Term Care Report

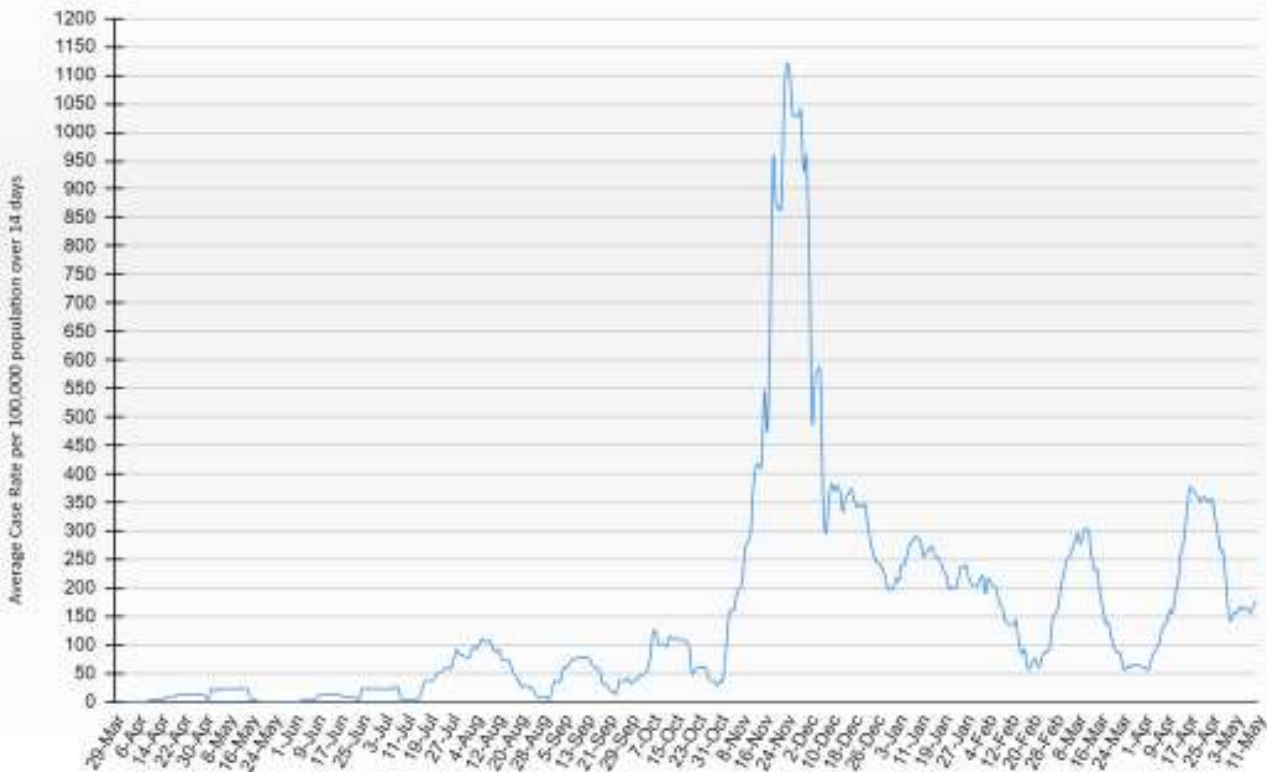
