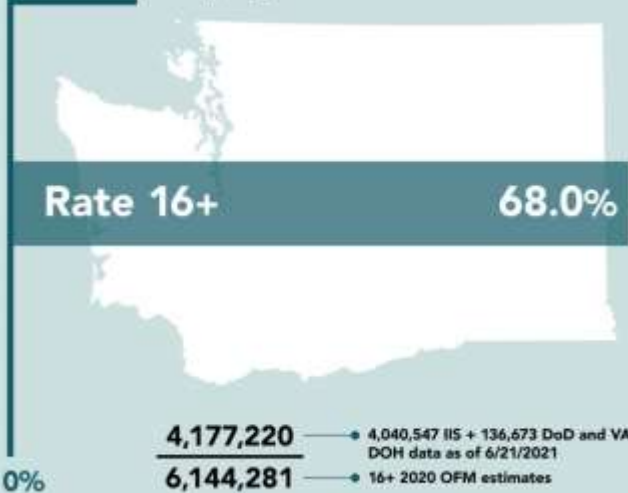

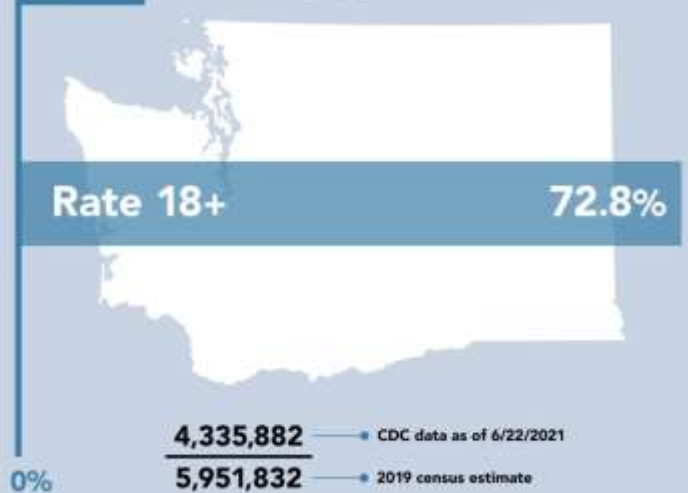

Hot Weather Forecast for Pacific County This Weekend

Here is the current outlook for the various geographic areas of Pacific County from the National Weather Service. The beach communities should expect to see weekend temperatures in the high 70's to mid-80's. South Bend can expect temps in the lower 90's. Raymond and Naselle can expect temps in the mid to upper 90's. Menlo, Frances, Lebam and Brooklyn could all reach into the 100's.

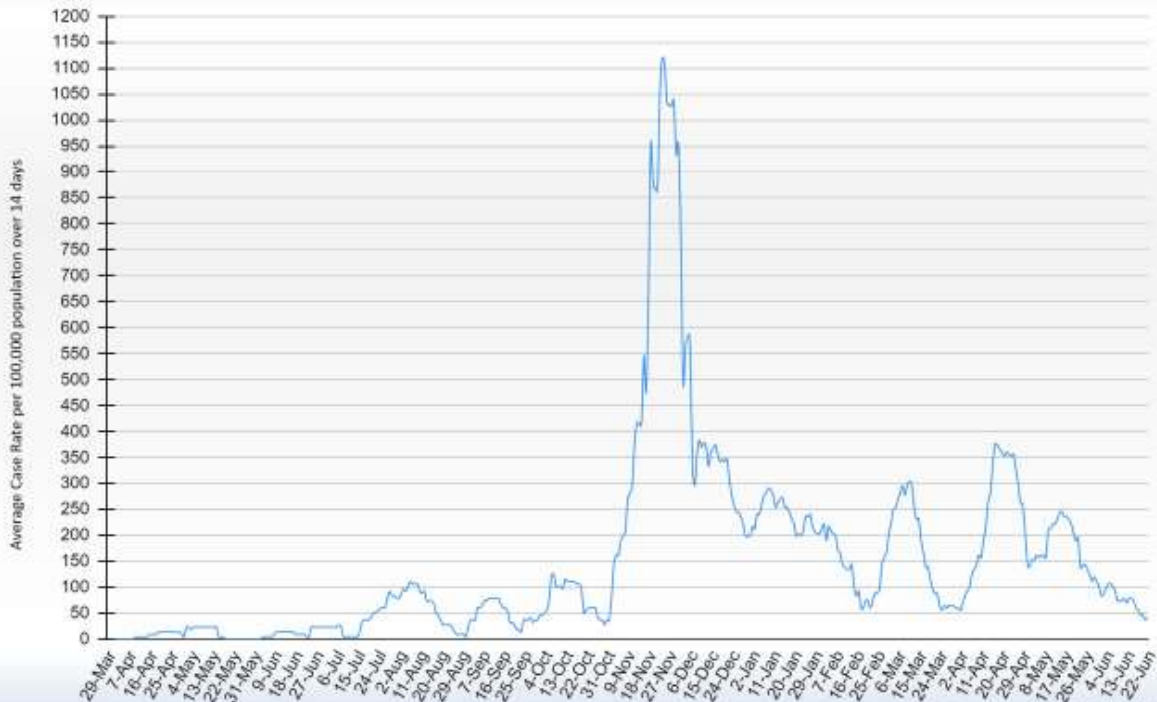
Exacerbating these temperatures will be relatively high levels of humidity and very little wind. These factors will make outdoor temps feel 2-3 degree higher than the actual temp. It appears that Pacific County will return to a more normal on-shore marine flow on Monday.
