26 Additional Positive COVID-19 Cases in Pacific County

Pacific County Public Health and Human Services has received notice of 26 additional positive cases of COVID-19 in Pacific County. These cases are new since November 11 and are in addition to the 165 previously reported cases for a total of 191 cases. There are currently 61 active cases being monitored by public health nurses, 40 of which are confirmed and 25 probable. Case investigations and contact tracing are on-going.
