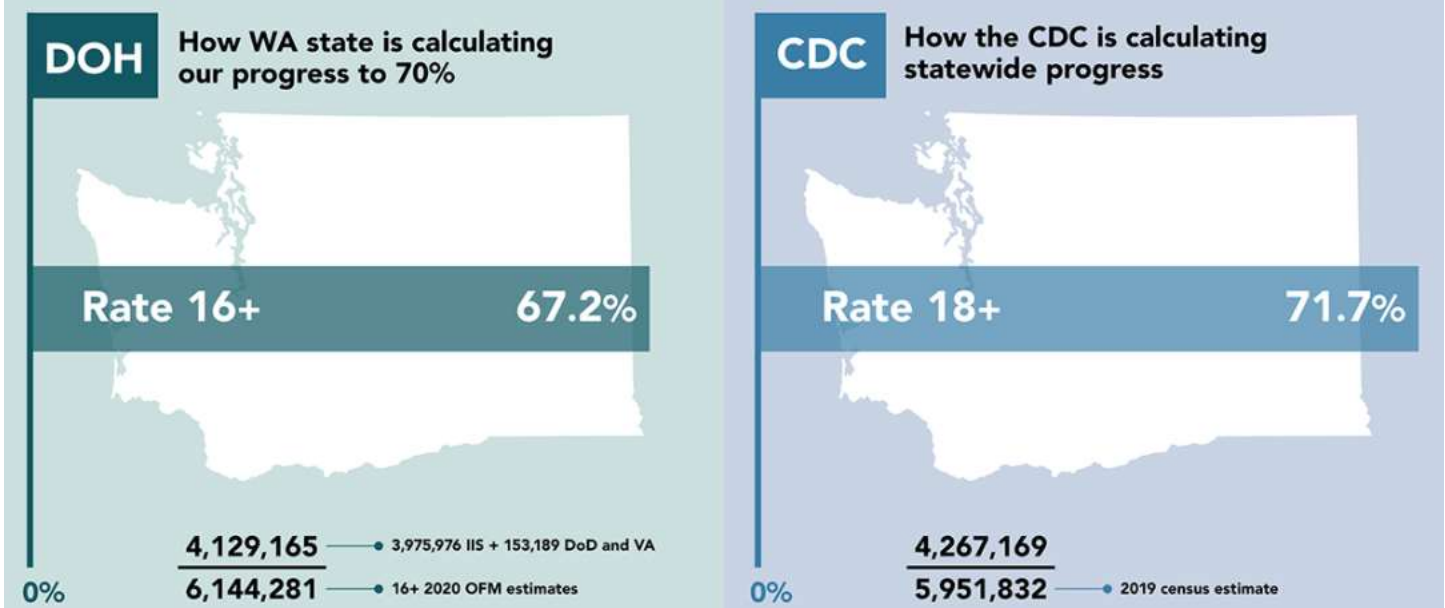
WA State Total Positive Cases as of **06/15/2021**: **445,155** WA Total Hospitalizations: **24,879**
WA Total Deaths: **5,800** Neighboring Counties: Wahkiakum County **154** cases, Grays Harbor **4,531** cases, Lewis County **5,202** cases, Clatsop County **1031** cases. Clatsop County will remain in the "Lower Risk" category of state-mandated COVID-19 business and social guidelines through at least June 24, based on the local rate of new infections. Under the Lower Risk designation, restaurants, gyms and indoor entertainment establishments may operate at 50-percent capacity, and faith institutions may allow up to 75-percent of capacity.

DOH Discusses Difference in Data Calculations Between State and CDC

The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) is aware there are differences between vaccination data displayed in the state's data dashboard compared to vaccination data in the

[Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's \(CDC\) COVID Data Tracker](#). DOH understands that there is a lot of excitement and anticipation surrounding the 70% vaccination threshold statewide. While the state hasn't achieved it yet (at last check, we are at 67.2%), the people of Washington are getting closer every day. The state's data dashboard represents the most accurate information the department has control over, but it is likely vaccination rates are higher for the following reasons:

- The state goal and dashboard reports for people 16 and up, and the federal government is reporting for people 18 and up.
 - DOH also uses population estimates from the Office of Financial Management, while the federal government uses census data.
 - DOH is including 153,189 DoD and VA people who have initiated vaccine to the current statewide total. However, the federal government gets data from DoD, VA, Bureau of Prisons, and potentially a few other sources that don't get automatically funneled to DOH state totals.

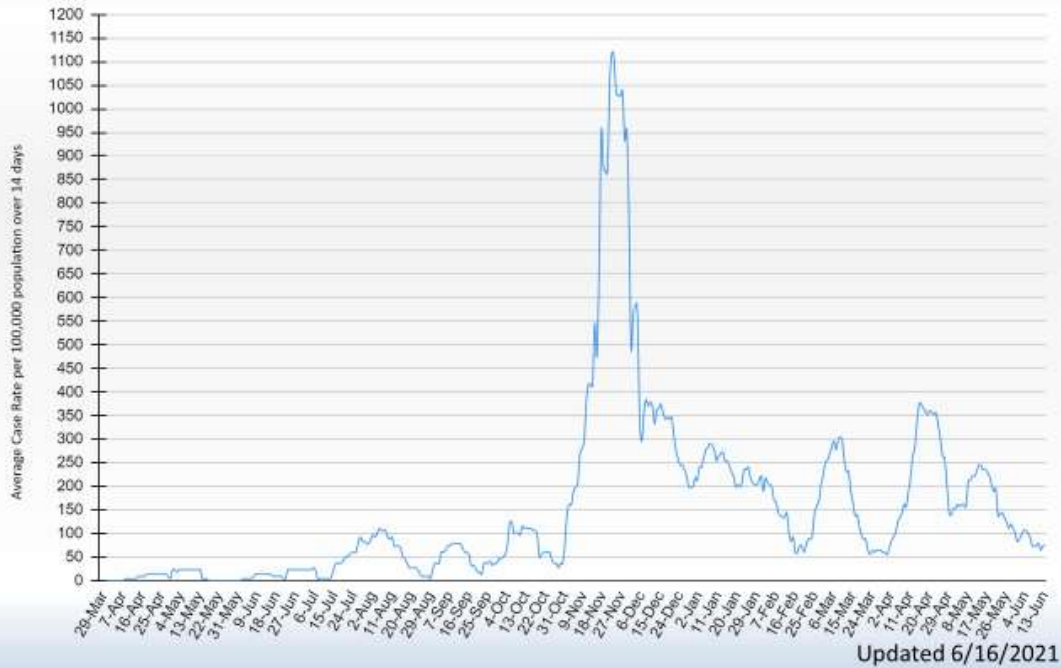
