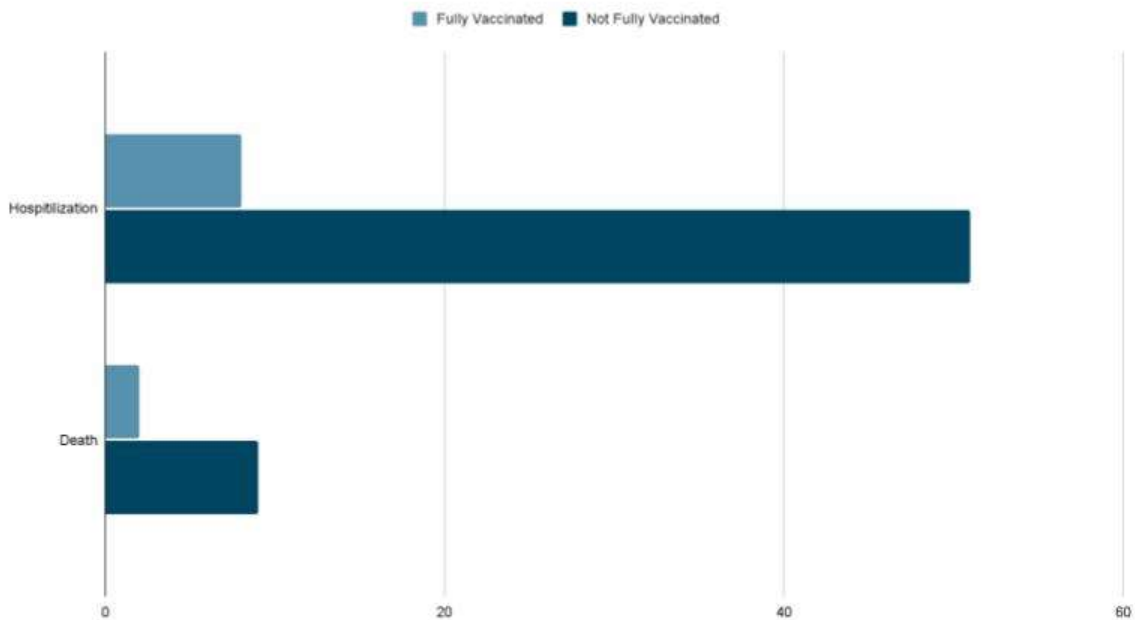

What you need to know if you have been exposed to COVID-19

You will be instructed to **quarantine for 14 days** after your last exposure to the person who tested positive. Under certain circumstances, individuals may be released early from quarantine. Please consult with a public health nurse to discuss your options.

Anyone who has had close contact with someone who has COVID-19 should be tested. Get tested as soon as possible if you have symptoms. If you do not have symptoms, it is best to **schedule your test 5 days after** your last exposure to decrease the chance of a false negative. 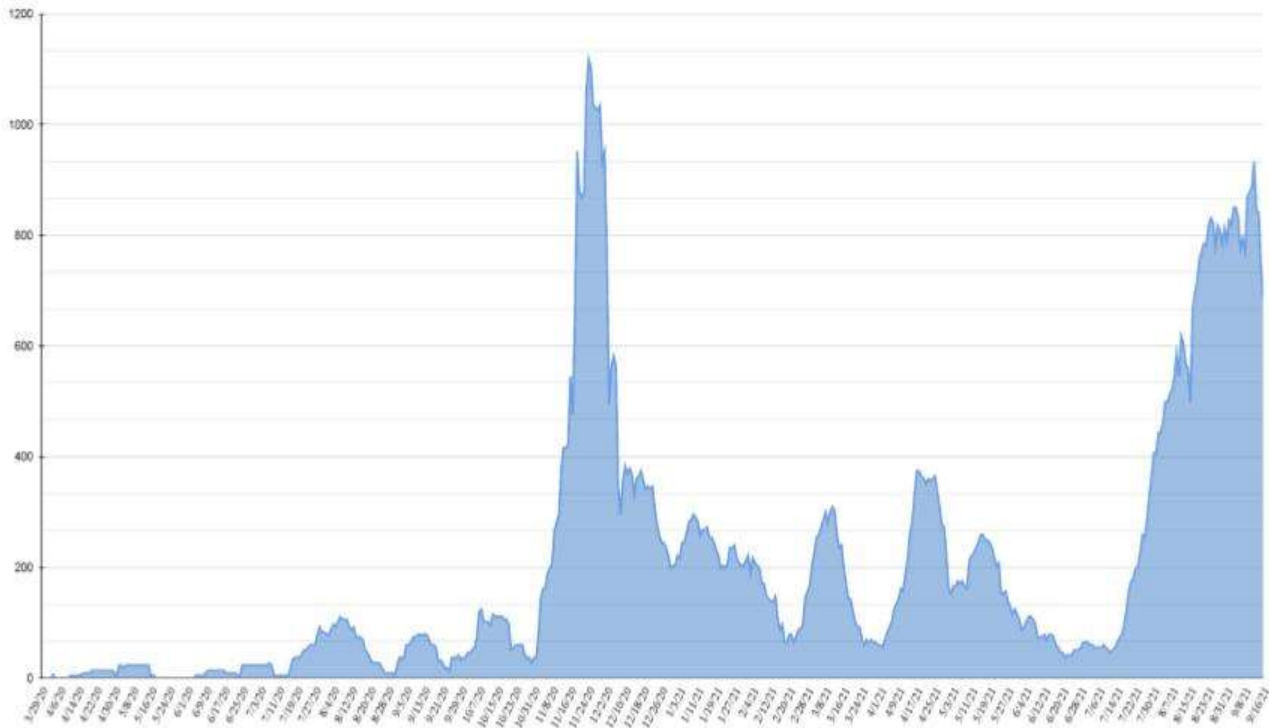

As of September 13, **75.1%** of the population 12 and up has **received at least one dose** and **68.1%** is **fully vaccinated**.
