**Have questions about Ivermectin?** Check out this interview with Pacific County Health Officer, Dr. Steven Krager as he shares information about Ivermectin and it's appropriate uses in humans. Ivermectin is an antiparasitic drug used commonly in humans and animals. Ivermectin tablets are approved by the FDA at very specific doses for some parasitic worms, and there are topical formulations for head lice and skin conditions like rosacea. But ivermectin is not an anti-viral (a drug for treating viruses).

Evidence to-date shows ivermectin is ineffective against treating COVID-19 and the side effects can be potentially dangerous. Using formulations intended for animals, which are often higher concentration, could lead to overdoses. Ivermectin should not be used to treat or prevent COVID-19.

The FDA has received reports of people being hospitalized after taking ivermectin intended for horses. In July, poison control centers across the country reported a five-fold increase in the number of calls for human exposure to ivermectin.

Some of the side effects that may be associated with ivermectin include skin rash, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain, facial or limb swelling, dizziness, seizures, confusion, sudden drop in blood pressure, severe skin rash potentially requiring hospitalization and liver injury (hepatitis).

Getting vaccinated continues to provide the best protection against COVID-19, particularly against severe illness leading to hospitalization and death.

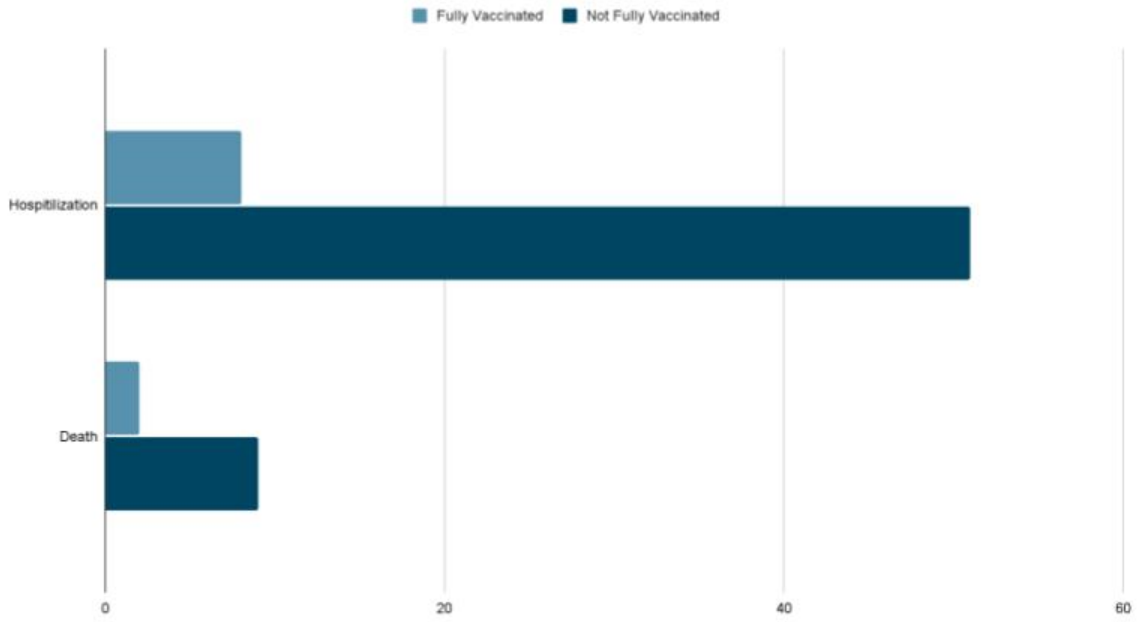

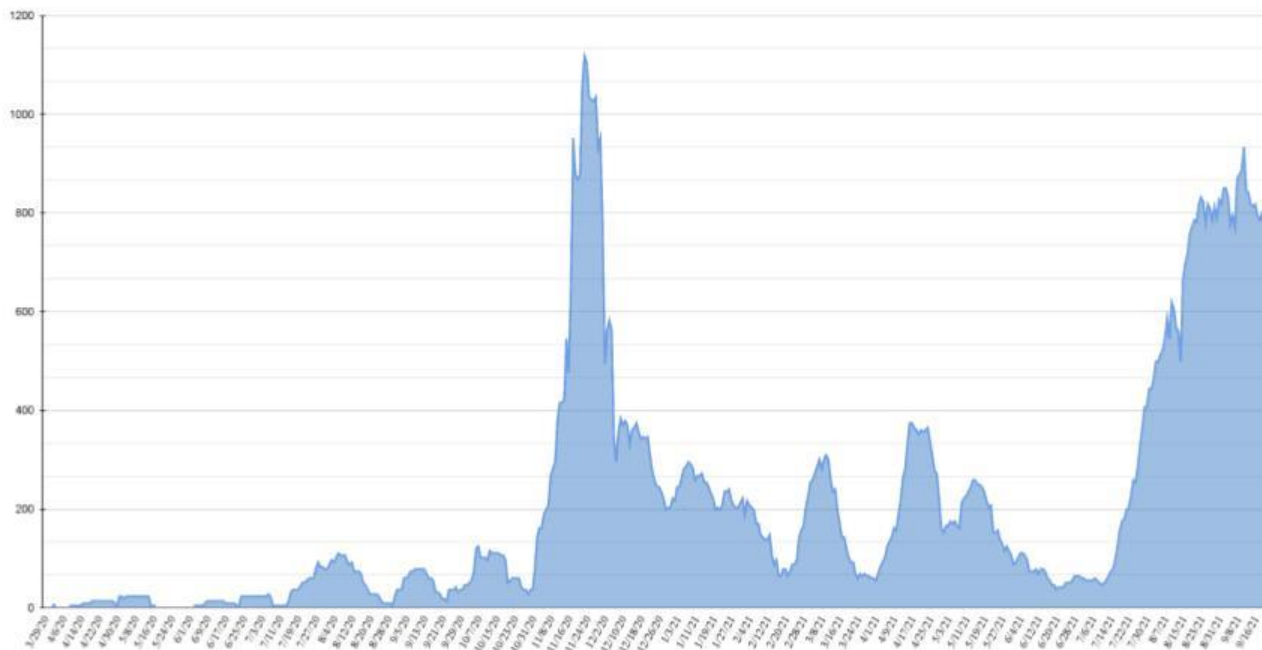
