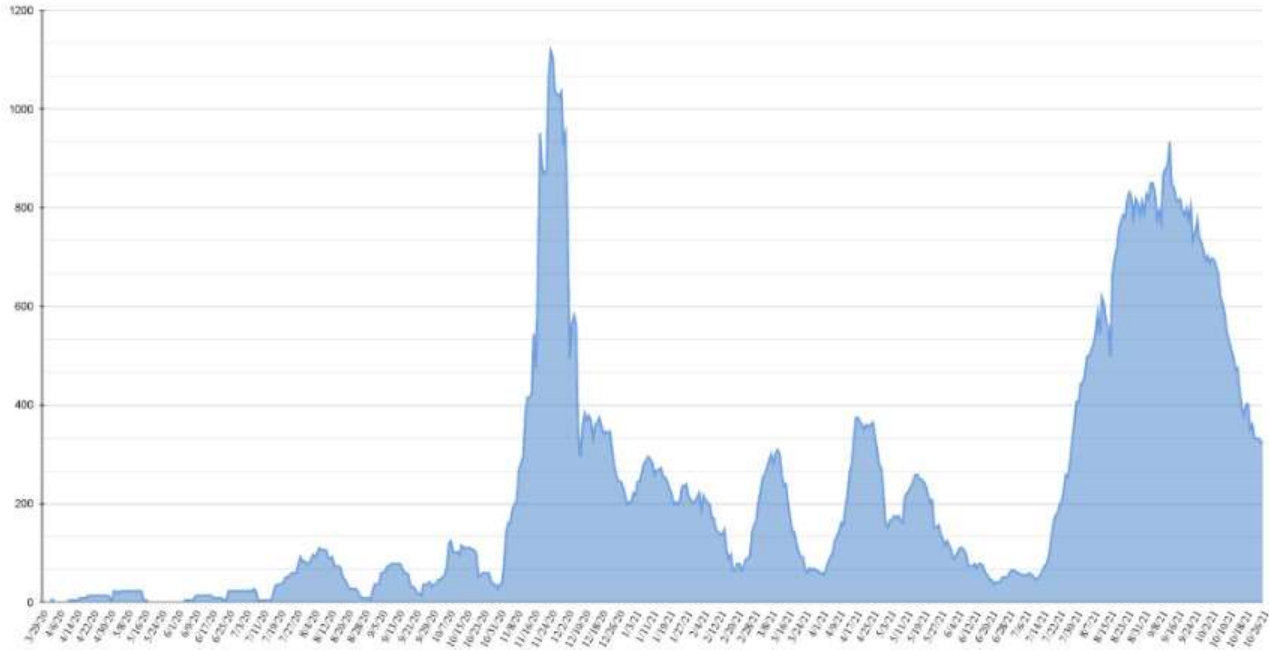

COVID-19 vaccine boosters

Am I eligible?

Pfizer or Moderna

The following groups are eligible for a booster **6 months or more** after completing the two-dose series:

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings

Johnson & Johnson

The following group is eligible for a booster **2 months or more** after receiving the single dose:

- 18 years and older

People who are eligible can choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose.

The booster dose **does not** have to be the same vaccine as the primary dose(s).

Talk to your health care provider if you have eligibility questions.
