\*Due to data cleaning that took place on March 24, our total case count has increased. These cases occurred over the course of the pandemic and do not represent a recent increase of cases.

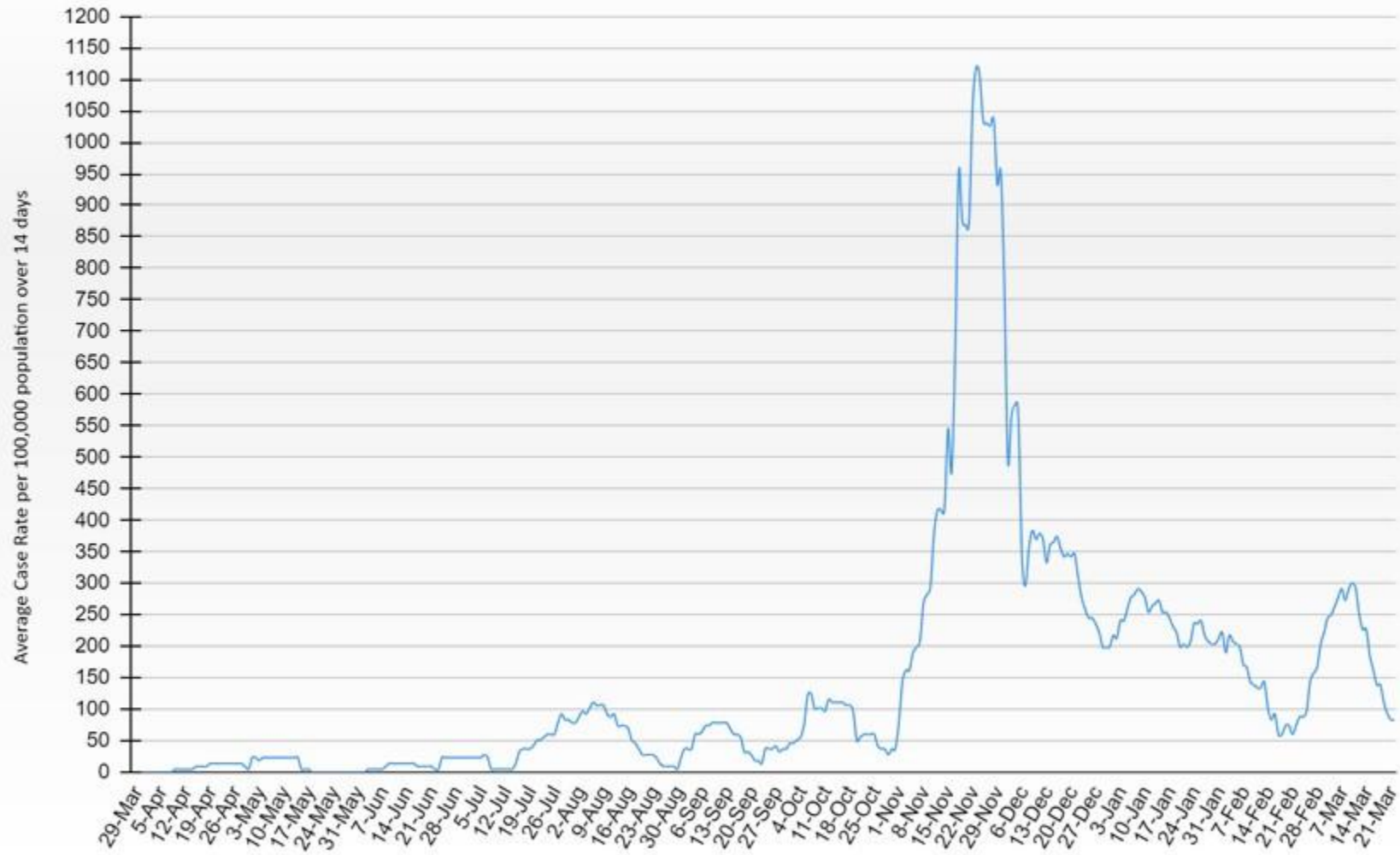
